



It is important to use nice words when talking to others










It is important to use nice words when I talk to my friends, my teachers and my family.

These are not potty words.




If things are not going my way and I am upset I can say things like...

These are not potty words.




If something smells I can say things like:

"It smells yucky"


"pee-u"

These are not potty words.




Sometimes my friends laugh when I use potty words because they think it's funny. I need to remember It's not funny and it's not nice to use potty words.





There are other ways I can make my friends, my teachers and my family laugh...,


I can tell a joke

I can draw a silly picture




When I sing songs I need to remember not to sing songs about potty words. There are a lot of songs I can sing that don't have potty words.




Sometimes it can be hard, but I need to remember to use nice words when talking with my friends, my teachers and my family.
